STONE LABORATORY - SUMMER 2009

Thank you for your interest in our program. Accompanying this note is information on The Ohio State University's 2009 summer college curriculum offered at Stone Laboratory.

To apply, submit the enclosed three-page Course Application (**do not submit any fees at this time**). An *Employment Application*, *Research Experience for Undergraduates Application*, and *Scholarship Application* are also enclosed if you are interested. To help you in selecting a course, view detailed course descriptions on our website: stonelab.osu.edu.

General Requirements for

- *Upper-Level Courses (500 and 600)*: normally require 15 hours of biological sciences and junior rank or above by summer 2009. (Some courses may have more specific prerequisites.)
- *Courses for Educators*: in-service teacher or education major with junior rank or above by summer 2009
- *Introductory Courses*: completion of one course of high school biology

Upon acceptance of your application, you will be sent a confirmation of course selection. In early April you will be sent a statement of fees due. Payment of room, meals, tuition and lab fees will be due May 15.* Upon receipt of this payment, you will be mailed an information packet from Stone Lab regarding your arrival/stay at the Lab.

Note: \$75 of the payment is nonrefundable.

Costs (subject to change)

- **Tuition Fee**** depends on number of quarter credit hours, graduate or undergraduate credit, resident or nonresident status (see tuition chart on enclosed brochure).
- **Room and Meals** (see chart on enclosed brochure)
- **Laboratory Fee**, \$40 per course for most courses
- **Books and Supplies**, approximately \$30-\$150 depending on the number of courses taken (these may be purchased on the first day of class at the Laboratory).
- **OSU Transcript Fee** (optional) \$7 per transcript request.

*Payment will be due June 1 if you are enrolled in the Term 2 session.

** Stone Lab courses are based on the quarter credit hour system.

Note: Students are required by OSU to have health insurance coverage; no exceptions.
