- 1.) A typed one- to two-page statement describing your academic achievements, career goals, and preferred research area. Your statement should also include information on why you believe attending Stone Laboratory will help you attain your goals.
- 2.) A copy of transcripts for all courses in which you received college credit. (Do not send advisor reports.)
- 3.) Two letters of recommendation from individuals, such as academic advisors, counselors, instructors, and school supervisors, who may attest to your scholastic record and qualifications. - 4.) Completed *Stone Laboratory Course Application*
- 5.) A personal resume, two pages max
